

## 2011-2012 ENTERING 9<sup>th</sup> REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Students are encouraged to visit with current teachers, Mr. Richards, or Mr. Jacobsen regarding any questions they may have about courses and programs of study.

Credits are awarded on the basis of 5 credits per course per semester; thus a typical course taken for a full year will earn a student 10 credits toward graduation. Students must receive a passing grade in a course in order to earn any credit for that course.

Graduation Requirements for AGHS students may be found listed on the accompanying Pre-Registration form. Please note that figures given for meeting graduation requirements are minimums only. Students planning on attending most four year colleges and universities will want to exceed AGHS requirements in order to assure admission. Ashland-Greenwood High School requires all students to register for at least seven classes, leaving no more than one study hall. The table below summarizes registration needs for 9<sup>th</sup> graders.
