Board of Education Meeting Elementary Principal's Report



May 18, 2015

Elementary Activities:

- Most field trips, Track and Field Days, and Friends and Family Days planned for May were held and enjoyed by all. Two events were rescheduled due to poor weather.
- 5th Grade students will visit the middle school on Wednesday, May 20. Students will tour the building, eat lunch with 6th grade students and then meet with each of the 6th grade teachers. Mr. Jacobsen will also meet with the students. This visit is designed to familiarize students with the middle school setting and the teachers to make the transition more comfortable for students.

Professional Activities:

- We held our final staff meeting on May 12th. The meeting focus was our elementary writing program which is the topic of my Action Plan and teacher's Student Learning Objectives. Grade level teams took time to reflect on their 2014.2015 plans for improvement and then identified next steps for the 2015.2016 school year. Teachers also had an opportunity to provide feedback and suggestions regarding the writing program. Jenny Washburn has participated in the NDE math standards revision process this year and provided information on some of the proposed changes as well.
- 2015-2016 class lists have been developed and distributed to teachers. Two sharing sessions will be held on May 18 and 20. The purpose of sharing sessions is to provide next year's teachers with pertinent information that will help the child transition smoothly to their new classroom next fall. Examples include reading levels, behavior plans, information regarding special services, medical information, etc...
- Evaluation conferences are underway and near completion.

Student Perception Data

Several recent studies have demonstrated the value of student surveys in assessing teacher effectiveness. The MET (Measures of Effective Teaching) Study found that student perception surveys were often more consistent than classroom observations or student assessment results in predicting teacher effectiveness. In addition, surveys provide important data for teacher improvement.

Our teacher evaluation model requires that student perception data be collected annually for each teacher in the Summative Year of the evaluation cycle.

Student perception data is NOT a rated component of the evaluation model. The student perception data is to be reviewed collaboratively by the teacher and the evaluator for the purpose of informing the development of the Individual Professional Development Plan (and/or Plans of Improvement or Plans of Assistance).

To alleviate some initial concerns expressed by staff regarding how the student perception results would be used, we choose to administer the student surveys as late in the year as possible after most end of the year evaluation forms have been completed.

The Evaluation Model does not require any specific commercial survey, length, content, etc.

We developed a short survey last year based on current areas of focus. Staff had input on survey contents. In order to be consistent, we are using the same survey this year. (All staff will then have student perception data collected via the same instrument.) We may then decide to revise the student survey for the next two years.

To help avoid ensuring students (esp. at the MS/HS) are not over-surveyed, the survey is just administered to one class/period per teacher. The surveys are administered to the class that the teacher identified for his/her SLO (Student Learning Objective) group.

The K-3 survey is a paper/pencil survey. 4th-12th grade students take an electronic version of the survey.

I will have copies of the student surveys available at the board meeting for your review. I will also have a sample student survey report for a teacher from last year for your review.



Board of Education Meeting: MS/HS Principal's Report, Brad Jacobsen: May 18, 2015

Activities/Calendar update:

- Graduation completed. 66 Graduates. 56 graduates in 2014, 71 in 2014. Only 1 student was not able to complete requirements and has continued to come to school with the goal of finishing his work by June 1 (or in summer school if necessary).
- (Brett, Hailey Pollard and Cassie Sunblade). 5 qualifiers in 2014, 4 in 2013.
- PLATTE VALLEY baseball has qualified for state for the first time ever! There are 12 AG kids on the team.
- District Golf is Monday, May 18 @ Woodland Hills. This has been the most competitive year for our golf team in quite some time.

Summer School:

- We have sent summer school invitations to students in grades 9-11 and our prepare our 'list' for grades 6-8.
- All MS aged students will receive support in Math and Reading/Language Arts daily.
- Goals: Support student learning, recover credits and get students 'caught up' if they failed 1 or 2 semesters of required courses (especially in Math, Science, and English).

Staff Development:

- As I meet with staff for yearend/summative & formative meetings, we are reviewing strengths, growth areas, and providing ideas for improvement. We have reviewed their draft of their own professional development plan and assure that it is connected with their evaluation. This eval process has been a LOT of work, but, I do feel like the product of the work is very strong and making a very real difference.
- Middle school careers and academic awards night is Tuesday, May 19. 8th graders have a culminating project of 'careers of the future' which is connected to our Bluejay Backer program that partners Ashland businesses with MS homerooms. Then, we will honor our MS students for academic excellence and growth this past school year.
- We had a 'staff celebration' this past Wednesday morning to share our 11th grade NeSA results. Data is not to be shared, yet, but we can review it as a staff. It's exciting to see our 11th graders do well because we feel it is a culmination of EVERYONE'S efforts and a reflection of our educational program. Again, this test doesn't really mean anything SPECIFICALLY to the Junior class (when compared to a test like the ACT) and for them to give such strong effort and perform so well is gratifying.
