## Mr. Bargen's Classroom Rules and Procedures

## Rules:

- **#3.** Get your assignments in on time. If an assignment is a day late the highest grade you can receive is a remediation grade (the lowest D, 60%). If handed in late on the day it was due, the highest grade possible is a 70%. You have 1 week to get any remediation done.
- **#4.** When a student is absent it is their responsibility to get make up work from me. If they fail to do so it will result in a zero in the grade book. If it is an UNEXCUSED ABSENCE, all class activities will be forfeited. (Includes tests, quizzes, homework due)
- **#5.** Respect yourself and others. This includes the teacher and your fellow students. If you give respect, you will receive respect in return.
- **#6.** Follow all the rules in the student handbook. (NO CHEATING)

## **Consequences:**

- #1. Warning either verbally or by eye contact.
- #2. Conference with teacher.
- #3. Parental contact.
- #4. Referral to the office.

## Rewards:

- #1. Self-satisfaction in completing requirements and passing the course.
- #2. Verbal praise and general body language (smile, nod, expression, etc.).
- #3. Special activities.
